

Seoul's niceworkshop releases exclusive new objects and furniture in Paris during PFW2023.

Oh Hyunseog, the founder of the Korean design studio "niceworkshop," based in Seoul, has been invited by long-time collaborator Marin Mornieux (RIMOWA) to exhibit exclusive new objects and furniture for the first time in Paris this summer.

Since Oh participated in the RIMOWA As Seen By exhibition around the world in 2022, "niceworkshop" has gained global recognition and has begun expanding beyond South Korea.

In June 2023, Marin and Oh will once again collaborate to inaugurate a dedicated exhibition space called '40 Dr' in a 19th-century Haussmannian building in Paris, which has been modernized in collaboration with the Paris-based design and craft studio Perron et Frères.

The showroom will also feature unique pieces from friend designers Illya Goldman Gubin (Berlin) and Tom Ducarouge (Paris), as well as exclusive stationery items from Seoul label & gallery HAHOUSE.
